Thereupon, Director <u>O. Ma</u> introduced and moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION SUMMARIZING EXPENDITURES AND REVENUES FOR EACH FUND AND ADOPTING A BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO EACH FUND IN THE AMOUNTS AND FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH HEREIN FOR THE COTTONWOOD GREENS METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 3, CITY OF FORT LUPTON, COLORADO, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY 2012 AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER 2012.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the Cottonwood Greens Metropolitan District No. 3 (the "District") has authorized its treasurer and legal counsel to prepare and submit a proposed budget to said governing body at the proper time; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budget has been submitted to the Board for its review and consideration; and

WHEREAS, upon due and proper notice, posted in accordance with Colorado law, said proposed budget was open for inspection by the public at a designated place, a public hearing was held at 4:30 P.M. on Thursday, November 3, 2011, and interested electors were given the opportunity to file or register any objections to said proposed budget; and

WHEREAS, the budget being adopted by the Board has been prepared based on the best information available to the Board regarding the effects of § 29-1-301, C.R.S., and Article X, § 20 of the Colorado Constitution; and

WHEREAS, whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE COTTONWOOD GREENS METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 3, CITY OF FORT LUPTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. <u>Summary of 2012 Revenues and 2012 Expenditures</u>. That the estimated revenues and expenditures for each fund for fiscal year 2012, as more specifically set forth in the budget attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, are accepted and approved.
- Section 2. <u>Adoption of Budget</u>. That the budget as submitted, amended and attached hereto and incorporated herein, is approved and adopted as the budget of the District for fiscal year 2012.
- Section 3. 2012 Levy of General Property Taxes. That the foregoing budget indicates that the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for the General Fund for operating expenses is \$1, and that the 2011 valuation for assessment, as certified by the Weld County Assessor, is \$20. That for the purposes of meeting all general operating expenses of the District during the 2012 budget year, and together with other available revenues of the District, there is hereby levied a tax of 43.000 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation of assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2012.
- Section 4. <u>2012 Levy of Debt Retirement Expenses</u>. That the foregoing budget indicates that the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for the Debt Service Fund for debt retirement expense is \$-0-, and that the 2011 valuation for assessment, as certified by the Weld County Assessor, is \$20. That for the purposes of meeting all debt retirement expenses of the District during the 2012 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 0.000 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation of assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2012.
- Section 5. <u>Certification to County Commissioners</u>. That the Secretary of the District is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the Board of County Commissioners of Weld County, the mill levy for the District hereinabove determined and set. That said certification shall be in substantially the following form:



SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ASSUMPTIONS

Services Provided

Through its Service Plan, the Cottonwood Greens Metropolitan District No. 3 (the "District") is authorized to finance certain streets, street lighting, traffic and safety controls, sewer improvements, landscaping, and park and recreation improvements.

Revenue

Developer Advance and Property Taxes

The primary source of funds for 2012 is developer advances. The District anticipates imposing a mill levy of 43.000 mills for the budget year 2012 for operations and maintenance expenses, which will yield \$1 in property tax revenue.

Expenditures

Administrative Expenses

Administrative expenses have been primarily for legal services, insurance and accounting costs.

Funds Available

The District's budget exists from the developer's advances to cover the District's operations, including its administrative functions.

Accounting Method

The District prepares its budget on the modified accrual basis of accounting.
